

GBMC Visitor Policy

Please review the visitor policy for the hospital before going into labor. The staff is required to adhere to this policy for the safety of you and your baby.

Labor & Delivery

Triage/Examination Rooms

1 visitor only

Birthing Rooms

5 visitors for labor and recovery

3 visitors for pushing and delivery

Operating Rooms/Prep Rooms/Recovery Room

2 visitors

* No children under 18 years of age

Hallways Outside of Birthing Rooms

Limit of 15 minutes outside of the rooms during quick procedures or exams.

No food or drink in the hallways

Please do not block doorways or hallways

Children

Only children (includes natural, adopted or step children) of the laboring patient are allowed on the unit.

No other children under the age of 12 are allowed on the unit.

Children must be accompanied by a responsible adult.

VIP Pass Holder

Pass holder is responsible for the entrance and exit of their visitors.

Parking

Daily Pass: \$4.00 (unlimited trips on same day)

Weekly Pass: \$10.00 (unlimited trips for 7 consecutive days)

Coupon Book: \$20.00 (10 trips with no time limit)

Postpartum Unit

- Visiting hours are 9:30am-8:30pm
- One significant other may stay 24 hours, with a VIP pass

- All other visitors, 4 maximum at a time (including significant other), must obtain a visitor pass at the OB Admitting Desk, and must observe regular visiting hours.
- Visitor pass must be visible as proof of identification while visiting the postpartum unit.
- Visitors must be cautious not to allow anyone to follow them onto the secure unit.
- Siblings of the newborn may visit during visiting hours (a pass is required for each child).
- Siblings must be supervised by a visiting adult at all times.
 - Children are not permitted to run in the hallway.
 - Children are not permitted in the hallway alone.
 - Children are not permitted to climb on the furniture.
- No other children under the age of 12 are permitted to visit due to infection control and security reasons.
- Children may only visit with their families. Visiting of other families is not permitted.
- No children under the age of 18 may stay overnight.
- Any visitors that have a fever, cough, runny nose, vomiting, diarrhea or have been recently exposed to communicable diseases (such as chickenpox) are not permitted to visit.
- All visitors must thoroughly wash their hands upon arrival on the unit.
- If you have a c-section and you want the baby to room-in, you must have someone spend the night with you on your first night in the hospital.
- Bring your laptop...GBMC has wireless internet connectivity available.
